2015 Enchanted Valley Pool Tags

Swim season is almost here and you must have a current 2015 Pool Tag to use the Enchanted Valley Pool. All residents who use the pool must be current on their maintenance fees. Pool tags are required by anyone 8 years or older. Swimmers 7 years and younger will not need a pool tag and must be accompanied by a responsible adult 17 years or older. Failure to abide by the Enchanted Valley Pool Rules or obeying the lifeguards may result in loss of the tag for the remainder of the swim season.
